Monitoring the water quality of the lake through frequent sechi disc and temperature testing.

Participating in the Love Your Lake Program to conduct a shoreline evaluation of all properties on South Lake, to determine overall lake health and provide individuals with confidential information on how to help preserve our water quality.

We urge all property owners to please take a long look at your Love Your Lake shoreline assessment, and make **even small corrections** to start, to naturalize your shoreline. If everyone participates, our lake will appreciate it. Little by little, we can make South Lake a little better every year!

<u>Social events</u>: Annual non-motorized poker run for all ages, South Lake Mystery Snail removal etc..
